Dear Buyers:

Welcome to the 24th annual Mississippi Beef Agribition, Saturday March 27, 2021. The Board of Directors would like to take this opportunity to express our sincere appreciation, to the consignors in this sale and to the buyers for their support of this special sale. We are grateful to the Pontotoc County Board of Supervisors, for allowing us to host this sale at The Pontotoc County Agri-Center in Pontotoc, Ms. 430 C J Hardin Jr. Drive, Pontotoc, MS. 38863.

As you study the sale offering, you will realize there are several opportunities to bring in any class of young females into your herd. We are offering over 50 pairs, some will be 3-n-1's, 15 heavy and 11 short bred and 90 open heifers. In addition we have a really good line up of bulls. 10 Angus, 1 Charolais, and 1 Simmental and 1 Sim/Angus and 2 Herefords.

Everyone knows we are in a very volatile market situation. Beef prices, especially for calves has seen an up turn in the markets over the past few weeks and as the national herd inventory begins to decline, stronger prices are expected to follow. As the markets move up and down, we as producers, must become better overall managers of the things that effects our profitability. Herd Health, Nutrition, Genetics, and Marketing are among the top concerns we must stay focused on, to turn a profit at the end of the year.

This sale offers some really good genetic packages, that will help you introduce better genetics into your herd. Having a live calf each year is very important, but having a live calf with the genetics to grow and reach an acceptable weaning weight is a must in these marketing times. Actually, in an up market or a down market, the producers with the higher performing genetics always have a better chance of being profitable for the year. Genetics alone, won't get the complete job done. Taking advantage of special sales such as this sale can help you acquire quality animals to add to your herd or it can give you an avenue to showcase your herd, which can give you more opportunities for off farm sales.

As in past years of the Mississippi Beef Agribition, Mr. Dusty Taylor and his brother Mark from Taylor Made Auctions in Rustin, LA. will auction the sale. Dusty and Mark are good friends to Mississippi beef cattle producers and they will be on hand Friday night, March 26 to evaluate the sale offering and to set the sale order. Just as in years past, buyers will sign up at the Sale clerk's table and receive their bidders number. If you are a new bidder to the Agribition, we ask

that you bring a letter of credit from your bank, which will speed up the sign up process.

The sale begins at 12:30 PM Saturday, March 27 beginning with the Bulls, followed by Pairs, Heavy bred, Short bred and concludes with the Open heifers. Once the sale begins, there will be no load-outs until the sale is concluded. This prevents any mistakes and assures that the cattle you bought are the only ones loaded on your trailer. Generally the entire sale takes about 2 1/2 hours and load out begins immediately after the sale concludes. No load out will be done without a load out ticket from the clerks table.

The Pontotoc Agri-Center is used for many different functions, and the pens have to start coming down Sunday after the sale, therefore, we ask you to make arrangements to remove all purchased cattle by 10 PM Saturday after the sale.

**Special Notes:**

- \*\* All bulls must have passed a BSE (Breeding Soundness Exam) from a licensed veterinarian. The bulls will also be screened by a three person committee at weigh in for any physical defects or disease issues. The day before the sale the bulls are weighed and this information will be available on the sale order sheet.
- \*\* Open heifers are guaranteed open by the seller.
- \*\* Bred heifers have been checked by the sellers veterinarian no more than 30 days before the sale to determine their pregnancy status. Any heifers found to be 60 days or less bred are not guaranteed to remain bred full term. Bred heifers found to be more than 60 days bred will be guaranteed bred by the seller. Any guaranteed bred heifers are guaranteed for 30 days after the sale. After 30 days all guarantees expire. Any heifers sold as guaranteed bred and are found to be open, no more than 30 days after the sale, by the buyers veterinarian, will be subject to a full refund to the buyer by the seller. 30 days after the sale all guarantees expire.

# TERMS, CONDITIONS AND GENERAL SALE INFORMATION

**TERMS:** Terms of the sale are cash. Settlements are to be made with the clerk immediately after the conclusion of the auction. The MS Beef Agribition acts as an agent only. The contract is between the buyer and the seller.

**BIDDING & DISPUTES:** All cattle will be sold at public auction to the highest bidder. The auctioneer will settle any disputes concerning bids, and the auctioneer decisions will be final.

**HEALTH:** By order of the State Veterinarian's Office, Mississippi producers are no longer required to have animal's blood tested for brucellosis. Health papers are **required** for all animals consigned to this sale. The health papers must indicate the pregnancy status of all females consigned to this sale. It is the responsibility of the buyer to know the health restrictions of his/her state and to be aware of the possibility of any subsequent testing of any animals purchased through this sale as required by law.

**REGISTRATION:** All bulls must be registered with their prospective breed associations. Properly signed certificate of registry transfers will be furnished to the buyer.

**BREEDING GUARANTEE:** Animals are guaranteed to be without defects, but nothing more. All sale bulls will have documentation of a passed breeding soundness exam, including scrotal measurements within 30 days prior to sale. Scrotal circumference measurement minimums for sale bulls are 32 cm for 12-16 month old bulls, 34 cm for 17-23 month old bulls, and 36 cm for 24+ month old bulls. Animals failing to breed, after a trial of six

months, may be returned to the seller, if in good condition. The seller reserves the right to try said animal for six months and, if it proves to be a breeder, to return it to the buyer at the Buyer's expense. If the animal proves to be a non-breeder, satisfactory exchange will be made or purchase price refunded.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS:** Announcements made from the auction block on sale day shall take precedence over information printed in the catalog. It is, therefore, the buyer's responsibility to pay attention to any such announcements.

**ANIMAL REMOVAL:** Bulls and/or heifers purchased at the Mississippi Beef Agribition must be loaded out by 10:00 P.M., March 27,2021

**LIABILITY:** All persons who attend this sale do so at their own risk. The owners or sponsors assume no responsibility, legal or otherwise, for any accidents that may occur.

### Understanding This Chart

**\*\* The Percentile Breakdown by each breed is a quick glance to determine where a bull of a specific breed falls when compared to all the bulls in that specific breeds data base. For example: an Angus bull with a 55 weaning weight would stand between the top 10% and top 25% of the breed for that trait. In the case of the Hereford breed, a bull with a 55 weaning weight would stand between the top 25% and the top 50% of the breed for that trait. Each Association has it's own data base and these Percentile Breakdowns should not be used to compare two bulls of different breeds: rather use these number to compare two bulls with the same breed.**

**\*\* Milk is a trait that we know is beneficial to a calf weaning at a heavier weight. Too much milk is can cause problems at breeding. The dam will be slower to come back into heat because she is producing so much milk that she can not manufacture enough of the hormones to cycle in a 60 to 70 day time frame after calving. In addition here in the deep south we generally do not have the enviromental conditions to allow a cow to reach here genetic potential from a lactation standpoint. Generally it is advised to know what the breed average is for milk in a particular breed and strive not to fall much below breed average or move your herd more than 15% above breed average.**

**\*\* Carcass traits generally do not gain much attention from Cow/Calf producers, especially if they sell calves at weaning. These traits are a road map of the beef industry's ability to produce consumer acceptable meats. All producers have a responsibility to injecting better carcass quality traits in their calves. The rub, is that, too often Cow/Calf producers do not get paid premiums for higher carcass quality calves. This become a management and marketing issue that is important, to show, buyers your calves have the genetic potential to be more profitable to them when being fed out. We must keep an eye on carcass tarits to compete with the other proteins available to consumers.**

Heifer development is a function of Nutrition, herd health and genetics. All work hand in hand to help a producer reach the desired goals of reaching maturity by 14 to 15 months of age, breed early, calve unassisted, re-breed in a timely manner and remain in the herd for many years. The major obstacle with first calf heifers is getting them re-bred. Usually there is a nutritional deficiency that prevents them from breeding back timely. 30 to 45 days prior to calving, the nutrition level must be increased to give heifers additional energy to calve, begin nursing, finish growing and prepare to re-breed.
